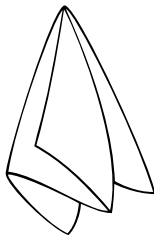


*An AFFECTED PROVINCIAL'S SUPPLEMENTAL:
Pocket Square Folds*

❖ No. 10: *The PUFF-AND-POINT* ❖

(Something of a curiosity: a puff with a “stinger,” casually executed. Ideal for silk or linen pocket squares.)



a) Hold the unfolded square by its center,
with all four points draping down.



b) Gather and fold the square at its midpoint,
forming a kind of loose “puff” at the top.



c) Fold the loose points behind the puff—but take one
of the square’s points and pull it up, so that it peeks out,
over the pocket.



d) Place into pocket, and adjust puff and point.
