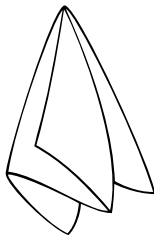


*An AFFECTED PROVINCIAL'S SUPPLEMENTAL:
Pocket Square Folds*

❖ No. 11: *The* DEMI-INVERTED PUFF ❖

(A dramatic, showy fold, casually executed. Ideal for silk pocket squares.)



a) Hold the unfolded square by its center, with all four points draping down.



b) Gather and fold the square at its midpoint, forming a kind of loose "puff" at the top.



c) Being the opposite of the puff, we place the fold on the bottom, with the points facing up—but unlike the inverted puff, the demi-inverted puff's "puff" peeks out the top of the pocket, along with all the points.



d) Place into pocket, and adjust puff and points.
