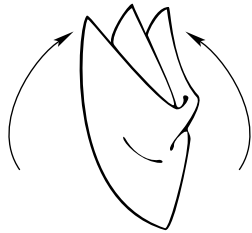


*An AFFECTED PROVINCIAL'S SUPPLEMENTAL:

✦ No. 13: *The CARROT-FOLD* ✦

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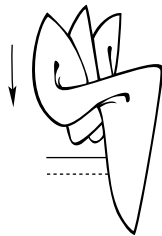
(A dramatic, showy fold, casually executed. Especially natty when cloth and suit are close in tone  
—or if one is sans tie, and one wishes to “defer the dash.”)



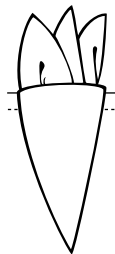
- a) Gather up three corners of the cloth in a row, with the remaining point draping down, as shown.



- b) Bend this configuration at its midpoint like a “z”, forming a kind of loose “seat” in the back, like a man sitting.



- c) This “seat” is then tucked into the pocket, with three points up, and the one point draped over the pocket’s front.



- d) Place into pocket, and adjust points.
